# 'Keep Calm & Dance On!' on May 21st & 22nd at Columbus Middle School Auditorium

#### **Mask:**

Mask will be required for everyone when entering the middle school. Dancers DO NOT have to wear a mask on stage unless if we do not received a signed waiver from parents. The school is working on putting together a waiver for us and we will email it out. We will need a signed copy for each dancer in order for your dancer to perform without a mask on stage.

### **What will my dancer wear?:**

Since this is an unusual year, we kept things simple for our families because we were not for sure if we could give you a normal recital. Not ordering costumes back in December was a difficult decision, but we did not want a repeat of 2020. Below are two charts, one for ages 6 & under classes and the other is for classes ages 7 & up.

<u>YOU will be responsible for ordering your dancer's recital tank top or t-shirt. We will email the link to order online and you can place your order.</u> Parents, grandparents and any other relatives or family friends can order recital apparel. We will order all of the leotards and you can purchase black leggings, black booty shorts or black ballet skirts through us or you can use your own.

Class	FOR AGES 6 & Under
Tiny Tots	Recital T-SHIRT with their IDP tutu and dancers can wear booty shorts or a black leotard under so they have coverage under their tutu with pink ballet tights and pink ballet shoes.
Snazzy Jazzy	GIRLS: Recital TANK TOP with their IDP tutu. Dancers can wear booty shorts or a black leotard under so they have coverage under their tutu with tan jazz shoes. Tights are not required.  Boys: Recital T-SHIRT, black shorts with no logos and black jazz shoes
Acro Minis' & Beg. Clogging	GIRLS: Recital TANK TOP with black booty shorts (no logos) and dancers will go barefoot. Tights are not required.  Boys: Recital T-SHIRT, black shorts with no logos and barefoot.
Preschool & Kinder Combo	GIRLS: Recital TANK TOP with their IDP tutu. Dancers can wear booty shorts or a black leotard under so they have coverage under their tutu with tan tights. They will need pink ballet shoes and black tap shoes.  Boys: Recital T-SHIRT, black shorts with no logos and black tap and ballet shoes.
Pre Ballet	Recital TANK TOP with their IDP tutu and dancers can wear booty shorts or a black leotard under so they have coverage under their tutu with pink ballet tights and pink ballet shoes.
Class	FOR AGES 7 & Up
Acro Level 1-6	Black and White Ombre Leotard with black booty shorts (of your choice). Tan tights are optional and dancers will go barefoot.
Ballet Level 1-5 & Pointe	Black and White Ombre Leotard with a black ballet skirt (of your choice), pink tights and pink ballet shoes.

Class	FOR AGES 7 & Up
All Jazz, Musical Theater, Lyrical/ Modern	Recital TANK TOP with black leggings (of your choice, no logos please). Dancer will also wear tan jazz shoes.  **Musical Theater will have an additional cost of \$19 for an umbrella for their dance.
All Tap & Clogging	GIRLS: Recital TANK TOP with black leggings (of your choice, no logos please).  Dancer will also wear black tap shoes for TAP & white clogging shoes for CLOGGING.  BOYS: Black Recital T-SHIRT with black pants and black tap shoes or white clogging.
Contemporary Level 1-4	Black and White Ombre Leotard with black leggings and tan jazz shoes.
Jazz Funk Level 1-3	GIRLS: Recital TANK TOP with black leggings (of your choice, no logos please) and your choice of CLEAN tennis shoes. <i>Jazz FUNK Level 3 will have an additional charge for a purple hat if your dancer hasn't already bought one.</i> BOYS: Black Recital T-SHIRT with black pants and your choice of CLEAN tennis shoes.

## **Recital Pictures: May 23rd at Goc's Creative Images**

Recital INDIVIDUAL pictures will be taken by Goc's Creative Images, located at 571 S 33rd Ave, Columbus, NE 68601 on May 23rd. We will provide a digital sign up at a later date. We will have set hours from 1-4:00pm on Sunday May 23rd.

As far as **GROUP** Pictures, we will take each class group picture the day of their dress rehearsals at the Middle School Auditorium. Below you will find their rehearsal times which will be held at Columbus Middle School Auditorium and we will take their class picture before we run through their routine on stage. This will not be an additional charge to you. These pictures will be provided along with some recital action shots in a digital drop box after recital. **Dancers can wear their hair however they want, but the must wear their correct attire for each routine for dress rehearsals and recital.** 

## **Dress Rehearsal:**

- ALL dress rehearsals are held at Columbus Middle School (May 19-21st).
- All spectators and dancers will need to wear a mask when entering the building.
- You will need to enter through the north east entrance. Guests remain in the lobby or auditorium, one parent and the dancer should proceed to the auditorium.
- Please arrive 30 minutes early so dancers can get stretched and ready for their rehearsals. We will also be taking group pictures right before their routine run through.
- When your dancer is done with their routine(s) at dress rehearsal, they are free to leave, same goes for recital.
- NO FOOD OR DRINK MAY BE BROUGHT BACKSTAGE OR IN THE THEATER DRESSING ROOMS or LOBBY ONLY!!!!
- Please no flash photography during dress rehearsal or recital for the safety of our dancers.

# **RECITAL DAY!!**

We will be having a 'Pre Show' for each recital. These will be soloist performed by our competition team members. The will be providing entertainment before the show begins.

# The middle school doors will be unlocked 40 minutes prior to each show.

Friday May 21st at 7pm (Show A): \*\*Competition Showcase\*\* Dancers should arrive no later than 6:30pm. The doors to the auditorium will open at 6:20pm for family members to take their seats. Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!

**Saturday May 22nd at 11am (Show B)**: \*\*Dance Classes ages 6 & under\*\* Dancers should arrive no later than 10:30am. The doors to the auditorium will open at 10:20am for family members to take their seats. \*\*If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 30 minutes after the show starts.\*\* Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!

**Saturday May 22nd 2:00pm Show (Show C)**: \*\*Dance Classes ages 7 & up\*\* Dancers should arrive no later than 1:30pm. The doors to the auditorium will open at 1:20pm for family members to take their seats. \*\*If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 45 minutes after the show starts.\*\* Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!

**Saturday May 22nd at 6pm Show (Show D)**: \*\*Dance Classes ages 7 & up\*\* Dancers should arrive no later than 5:30pm. The doors to the auditorium will open at 5:20pm for family members to take their seats. \*\*If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 45 minutes after the show starts.\*\* Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!

- Please arrive with hair and make-up done for RECITAL. Make sure to pack extra ponytails, hairspray, bobby pins
  etc., to retouch hair. Due to the stage lights, we suggest that dancers wear make-up. It is NOT required, but the
  stage lights can wash our your dancers and make them look as white as a ghost. To avoid this dancers should
  wear lipstick and blush. Mascara, eyeliner, eyeshadow and foundation is optional. Dancers can wear glitter in
  their hair or on their eyes, but please apply at home and not at the high school.
- You are NOT allowed to video tape during the recital, ONLY during the dress rehearsal. If you are caught video taping during the show you will be asked to leave. Please respect our request. We will have a professional videographer for two of our recitals: SHOW B & C. You will be able to purchase a recital DVD for Show B & C (show D is the same as show C). The cost will roughly be \$35 per DVD. More info to come.
- There will be a ten minute intermission during each recital. EXCEPT FOR SHOW B. You may only pick up your child it they are done dancing after intermission.
- If anyone must exit the theater during any of the shows for any reason, please do so between numbers.

- At the end of the recital, dancers are can be part of the final bow. We ask for dancers to head back stage during the last few numbers of the recital. After the recital, they will be dismissed from the stage.
- Dancers are allowed to bring personal belongings to keep them entertained, but please LABEL EVERYTHING.
   The school or iDance will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Dancers are allowed to bring food and water into the dressing rooms. We ask that they pick up after themselves
  and to keep snacks nut free and refrain from anything that will make a huge mess.
- HAVE A WONDERFUL PERFORMANCE! Your enjoyment, the student's safety and happiness is our primary
  concern. Please ask questions to clarify any of our request. We welcome your comments and feedback to help
  us help you and your dancer(s) have a wonderful recital weekend!
- Do reduce the amount of people waiting in the lobby, flowers will NOT be sold this year.

## **Backstage Help:**

We will need helpers to help backstage during recitals. We will provide a link by the end of the month to sign up electronically.

Backstage helpers and Ushers will NOT need a recital ticket. Room moms will be able to watch their dancer's routine backstage after their assigned class is done performing, you will take the dancers back to their assigned dressing room.

#### **RECITAL TICKETS**

Tickets will be sold online through Dance Recital Ticketing starting on Tuesday May 4th at 8am for graduating seniors and 12pm for the rest of the IDP families. We will email the direct link the day before with additional instructions. The link will also be posted on our Facebook page and our website. Seats will be assigned, therefore, everyone who will need a seat will be required to purchase a ticket. Children who are able to sit on an adults lap and Backstage help will NOT need a ticket.

When you purchase your tickets online, you will be able to purchase tickets for more than one show at the same time. You will have to select your seats for each show you wish to purchase tickets for. I attached a picture for you to look at to see how their system works. There is a large green button on top of the seating chart where you will select which show you would like to purchase tickets for. If you are purchasing tickets for more than one show, you will click on the green button "Add Seats for Another Show" on the right side of the screen.

The cost of the recital tickets is \$6 each which plus the service charge. All tickets will be available to print from your own computer or you be emailed a digital copy. Please note, you will need a credit or debit card to buy tickets, and that tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis. Tickets sold at the door will be \$10.00

\*\*\*Auditorium Doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show. Anyone who enters the auditorium during the show will be assisted by the usher and will not be allowed to go to their seats until instructed.
